Thank you for choosing Holy Family Catholic School for your children. I truly appreciate your ongoing commitment and support to provide your children with the highest quality Catholic education, putting them on the path to college and heaven.

Preparations are underway for the 2022-23 school year. As a current family, re-enrollment is available beginning today Monday, January 10, 2022 until Monday, January 31, 2022. All re-enrollment must be completed online through RenWeb. Please take advantage of this early registration period to confirm your place for the 2022-23 school year and a registration fee of \$200 per student. We cannot guarantee placement once open enrollment for new families begins and the registration fee increases to \$300 per student after January 31, 2022.

Siblings of current students may apply for admission during this re-enrollment period. These applications will be prioritized over new families if received on or before January 31, 2022.
